IIM Bangalore will host the XVII International Conference on Public Policy & Management from August 22 to 24, 2022. The interdisciplinary conference draws scholars representing a diversity of perspectives on public policy issues and provides a forum for showcasing the latest developments in policy research and practice. The conference typically hosts academic sessions, topical policy debates, workshops, panel discussions and practitioner-oriented discussions on contemporary topics on public policy and management.

The conference would be ideal for academicians, policy regulators, NGO professionals and anyone with an interest in public policy.

## Venue

Considering the ongoing pandemic and the uncertainty it entails, the organising committee has decided to go forward with a hybrid model - it will be a combination of virtual as well as physical event and participants can decide what suits best for them and how they wish to attend the conference. Virtually, it will be conducted via Zoom and the situation permitting physical part of the conference will be held at the IIM Bangalore campus.

## **The online registration process is open.**

The **primary themes** for the conference include:

- Social and Income Security (including UBI, DBT and other initiatives)
- Social Movements
- Climate Change
- Emerging Role of Technology including Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning

Theoretical and empirical papers shedding light on how particular domains shape or are shaped by public policy, opportunities and constraints of institutional arrangements and social as well as economic contexts shaping public policy are welcome. Papers not in these domains but related to public policy broadly are also welcome.

## **Guidelines for Paper Submission**

- The limit of your paper should be 5000-8000 words
- Please use British English
- Please send your paper using MS Word format, Times New Roman font, 12 font size, 1.5 line spacing
- Please send author/co-author's biography indicating affiliation, designation and contact details
- Please check grammar, punctuation and spelling before submitting your paper
- Please email your paper to [cppconference@iimb.ac.in](mailto:cppconference@iimb.ac.in)

Contributors can also propose a Special Panel Session comprising multiple (3-4) papers. Participants are limited to one paper presentation and one roundtable/panel appearance. Additional co-authored papers are allowed only if they are presented by the co-author.



## Registration Fee

- All applicants and participants need to pay a registration fee of Rs. 1000
- A conference kit will be provided to all the presenters; soft copy of the same will be provided to all the attendees
- In case of a paper with multiple authors, the same amount of Rs. 1000 will be charged in case the co-author/co-authors wish to attend the conference
- All applicants must first register; that would require them to pay the fee before they proceed to submitting their papers
- Once registered, participants can attend the entire conference spread across three days
- Upon acceptance and presentation of a paper, an equivalent amount of delegate fee will be provided in the form of gift voucher, to be mailed to the authors after the conference
- Bonafide students will be exempted from paying the registration fee

## Travel & Accommodation Grant

The organizing committee will provide travel allowance to 15 bona fide PhD students on merit basis. This would include a round trip economy air ticket and accommodation at the IIM Bangalore guesthouse. The decision of the committee will stand final.
