While working on a services project, he developed a software solution for a business problem and went on to patent this invention, for which he won the Infosys Award for Innovation in 2010 for generating IP. At IBM India, Kiran specialized in pre-sales work of connectivity and integration, mobile development platform and application infrastructure products, and contributed to several big wins for IBM during his tenure in the WebSphere pre-sales team. He then moved into IBM India Software Labs and joined the IIB development team, where his focus area is performance and reliability of the product and its release effectiveness.

His growing up years – his father was in the Defence forces and Kiran schooled at the Kendriya Vidhyalaya schools – exposed him to diversity. Apart from academics, his interest lies in sports and he has participated in swimming, yachting, football, volleyball and basketball at various competitive levels.
